14 Miles East of Salida, CO on HWY 50 or...
45 Miles West of Canon City, CO on HWY 50

On Site Camping:

Dry camping will be available at the event site starting Wednesday night. Camping is primitive with no water or electricity. Camping is in a field and there is no natural shade in the camping area. There will be portable toilets on site.

Fees:

- FREE to Spectators
- Riders/Minders will have a \$20 per day, \$40 total, land use fee for both days.
- Camping is on public land and will be FREE of charge.

Additional Information:

- In wake of trials legend Mr. Bill Markham's passing, there will be a memorial gathering held on Friday, June 14th at 5pm, at Turkey Rock. There will be a FREE spaghetti dinner to follow. - Friday Tech Inspection will be moved to 2-4pm with Mr. Bill's memorial starting at 5pm.
- Tech Inspection is also open from 8:00-8:30am on Saturday and Sunday.
- First riders out at 9am on Saturday and Sunday.
- Awards to follow ASAP after last rider is done on both days.
- There will be a Youth Event on Friday and Saturday for children 13 years old and younger. AMA membership is required for all riders but the STRIDER class. **NO ENTRY FEE!!** Friday start time is 1:00pm and Saturday start time is 10:30am. - **Spark arrestors and Colorado Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) permits are required. PLEASE get your permits ahead of time: <https://cpw.state.co.us/buyapply/Pages/RegistrationsOHV.aspx>.**
- The Turkey Rock Trials Area is restricted to trials motorcycles only, make sure any riding is done within the area boundaries.
- NO arriving before Wednesday. Practice area will be open starting Thursday morning.

- NO generators between the hours of 10 pm to 7 am.
- NO food vendors will be on site. Please plan accordingly.
- Dogs must always be leashed. Please pick up after pet waste.
- Salida and Canon City will be the two larger towns for any needed supplies. Salida is approx. 20 minutes from trials site and Canon City is approx. 60 minutes from the trials site.

Directions: Travel to Howard, CO (on US HWY 50 between Salida and Cañon City)

Coming from East (Canon City)	Coming from West (Salida)
Turn R (Northeast) on CR 47 – go 0.3mi	Turn L (East) on Howard Creek Rd/CR 4 – go 0.5mi – turning right to stay on CR 4
Turn L (Northwest) on CR 45 (just past RR underpass and RV park) – go 1.3m	Turn R (South) on CR 45 – go 0.6mi
Turn R (East) – on Sand Rd – follow ribbon and signs to pit area ahead	Turn L (East) – on Sand Rd – follow ribbon and signs to pit area ahead
