Supplementary Event Rules

1. A land use fee of **\$10 per day (\$20 max for weekend)** will be collected for each rider and person present (12 and under free), with a **\$25** fee for camping per unit.
2. There will be a **\$10 per day, (\$20 max for weekend)** per day fee for spectating.
3. Riders should stay in designated practice areas prior to the event. Sections are off limits until the event and riders/minders will be disqualified if found at or in sections prior to the event.
4. **NO ALCOHOL** is allowed on Stock Ranch property. This event is on private property, please respect the property and leave no trash.
5. **GENERATORS OFF 9 PM TO 8 AM**
6. Porta johns and a roll off for trash will be available in the pit area.
7. This area is rugged, rocky canyons with high desert conditions. Expect warm day temps but cool nights as soon as the sun goes down.
